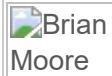

My family moved to Taylor when I was 8 years old. I was not happy about the move, and very sad and scared to be attending a new school.

My first day, lots of kids were lining up and milling around outside the doors of Blair Moody elementary school. I am sure I was watching from afar, very scared and shy. This really brilliant-blond kid in a black turtleneck came up to me and introduced himself as Brian, and asked if I was new. He walked with me to the line, and became my very first friend in Taylor. I lived further down on the same street as he did, so we sometimes walked home together, at least as far as his house.

We had a sometimes teasing friendship. Brian was dressed as a sort of rag doll one Halloween, probably around 1978. He had a wig made of red yarn on. I kept going up behind him and messing in it, saying, "Knit one, purl two." He eventually realized my Princess Leia buns were also made of yarn, and turned it right back on me. I had to give him the win on that one. :)

It's been a very long time since I last saw Brian. He was managing the Meijer store in Taylor at the time, and I remember he looked very handsome in a nice blue suit. We said hi and spent a couple minutes catching up. I had not seen him after that.
