Kevin was born to James and Patricia Poirier on September 17, 1960 in Detroit, MI. Kevin grew up in the Detroit area and graduated from Michigan State University with a CPA degree and received a Master's degree in Business at Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan. He married Angela Willger on September 5, 1987. Kevin worked as a CPA and was the co-founder of Beacon Promotions Inc. in New Ulm, MN in 2003.

Kevin loved rock n' roll music, enjoyed reading suspense novels, playing softball and cards (500 being his favorite) of which he was very competitive. Kevin is survived by his wife Angie Poirier; children Michelle Poirier (Steve White), Renee Poirier, Anthony "AJ" Poirier; brothers and sisters Mike (Elizabeth) Poirier, Catherine (Tom) Willger, Celeste Leach, James (Laurie) Poirier, Chris (Sue) Poirier, Mari (Luigi) Pecci and the late Earl Poirier.
