November 14, 1921 - August 28, 2017

Mary Theresa Antolczyk celebrated 95 years of a life well lived. Surrounded by the love of her family, God called her home on Aug. 28, 2017. Born on Nov. 14, 1921 to immigrant parents, Frank and Stella Bojanowski, she wished for her family the same things that brought her parents from Poland to Ellis Island at the turn of the century. Her life's work was being a Wife, Mom, Grandma and Busia – she did it well, always believing family is where life begins and love never ends. A graduate of Our Lady of Mount Carmel High School in Wyandotte, she also worked for a short time at the Wyandotte Toy Factory. Married on Aug. 12, 1944 to Stanley, they celebrated 51 years of marriage before his death in 1996. She was also preceded in death by her beloved sister, Helen Malkowski, brother, Edward Bojanowski, and many members of the Bojanowski and Antolczyk families.

Over the years, Mary enjoyed vacationing in northern Michigan, fishing trips with relatives, and of course, always the consummate Detroit Tigers fan.
