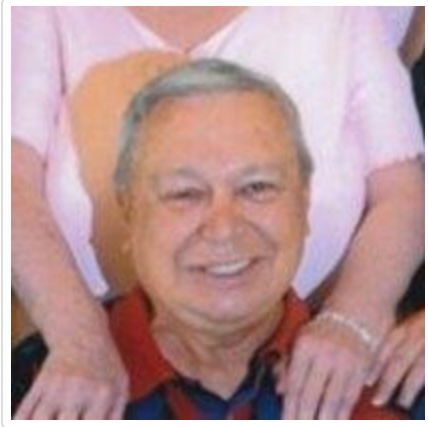




Ted C. Gronda
